Definitions

Recreation Area - The land owned by the Association.

Pool Enclosure - The fenced-in area.

Pool - the main body of water.

Baby Pool - the body of water enclosed by the low fence.

Staff - manager and lifeguards.

Responsible Person - a person 12 years of age or older and deemed responsible by the Staff.

Class "A" Rules

Registration - All members must register themselves and their guests at the gate upon entering the Pool Enclosure.

Pool Hours - Will be published in the annual letter that goes out to all members and posted at the pool bulletin board. The Pool will be closed for swim meets and other special events. The Baby Pool will also be closed during swim meets and practices. Times for these events will be posted at least one week in advance on the bulletin board. The Recreation Area or specific portions thereof can be closed by the Board of Directors or the Staff, in the interest of health, safety and general welfare of the members and guests.

Staff - The Staff will be in charge at all times and shall have authority to enforce all rules, including dismissal from the Pool Enclosure or limiting of activities of anyone exhibiting unbecoming conduct or disturbing the safety and enjoyment of others. The Staff is responsible for the safety, health, discipline and maintenance of the Recreation Area and are not to be diverted from their duties for any other purpose.

Health - Each person must take a soap shower immediately before entering the Pool and upon re-entering after using suntan lotion or cream. Any person having a communicable disease, skin eruption, fungus infection, eye, ear, nose or throat infection must not enter the pool. Person having abrasions or sores which have not healed or who are wearing any type of bandage will not be permitted in the Pool. All personal injuries sustained in the Recreation Area, however slight, must be reported immediately to the Staff. Expectorating or clearing one's nose in the Pool is prohibited. No pets will be permitted in the Recreation Area at any time.

A list of applicable rules and regulations of the State of Delaware Department of Health is available upon request and will be in effect to the same extent as if included herein.

Safety - No one is permitted in the Pool or Baby Pool unless a Staff member is on duty. Children between the ages of 7 and 12 years who are unable to swim one length of the Pool shall remain in the care of a Responsible Person at all times when in the Pool Enclosure. The Staff may require anyone in the Pool Enclosure to demonstrate such ability.

Children under the age of 7 years must be in the care of a Responsible Person at all times within the Recreation Area.

Children under the age of 2 years are permitted in the Pool under the following conditions only:

The child's parent/guardian/Responsible Person must be in the Pool and maintain physical contact with the child at all times. Do not depend on floatation devices.

The child must be wearing tight-fitting plastic pants or swimmie disposable diapers.

The Baby Pool is restricted to children 6 years old or younger. **Children in the Baby Pool are solely the responsibility of their parents/guardians and are not under the supervision of the Staff.**

Running in the Pool Enclosure is absolutely forbidden. Pushing, ducking, throwing objects, or other types of horseplay are not allowed. Diving in those sections of the Pool under 4' deep is prohibited. Only one person is permitted on the diving board at one time. No diving is permitted from the side of the board. No hanging on the diving board. Divers must swim out and away from the board as quickly as possible after each dive. The Staff may prohibit diving when in their opinion conditions so warrant.

Use of any swimming equipment must be first approved by the Staff. Any flotation device or equipment which requires inflation such as rafts or mats are not permitted in the Pool.

The life guard chairs are to be used only by the Staff and climbing, swinging, or jumping from the chairs is forbidden.

No glassware or glass containers are permitted in the Pool Enclosure.

Other Rules

Gambling by anyone under the age of 18 is forbidden.

No loitering will be permitted in the bath houses.

No one is allowed in the check-in office or pump room without permission of the Staff.

Bicycles must be parked in the area designated for that purpose.

All unclaimed lost articles will be disposed of after two weeks.

The stairs and ladders in the Pool must be kept clear at all times.

No hanging on the ropes in the Pool.

No climbing on the fence.

No skateboards or water guns.

Only whiffle balls are allowed for playing ball in the Recreation Area.

Rule Violation Procedure

When rules are violated, the Staff will take the following actions:

- First Offense: warn member that he/she is breaking a rule. The Staff will explain the rule.
- Second Offense: Request member to sit in a designated area for 5-20 minutes or perform certain housekeeping chores.
- Third Offense: Request member to leave the Recreation Area for the day; if a minor is involved, a parent/guardian will be notified.

The Staff has the discretion, depending on the seriousness and frequency of the rule violation, to go directly from First Offense to Third Offense.

Guests - Members are permitted to have guests at any time. These guests must be accompanied and registered by the Staff in the guest log and must leave the Pool Enclosure when the member leaves. No local resident may be escorted as a guest more than five occasions per season exclusive of special functions. House guests(those who reside at least 25 miles from the Recreation Area) are permitted at all times when the Pool Enclosure is officially open and do not necessarily need to be accompanied by a member. These guests must present the proper pass and register at the gate.

All guest fees must be paid by check. No cash can be accepted by the Staff under any circumstances.

Non-swimming adult guests of members and potential members desiring to inspect the Recreation Area may be admitted to the Pool Enclosure at the discretion of the Staff. No guest fee will be charged.

Class "B" Rules

The Pool is not to be used for private parties.
